Tropical "Storms" & "Waves"

Tropical Storm *Bonnie* was downgraded to a tropical wave today, but it is still interfering with the oil clean-up in the Gulf of Mexico.

It was an unnamed tropical wave when it passed over us. We are just emerging from many days of very wet and rainy weather (today is the first sunny day in more than a week).

The major daily newspaper here says that 37,000 people have had to be evacuated from their homes because of flooding here. We do not live in a low lying area, but have still seen some extra water recently. You can view a [video taken on our street here](#).
